

Declaration from the 2014 European Summit

We, the undersigned participants of the Israel Allies European Summit, unequivocally declare our support for the Jewish people to live in peace, safely and securely in the Land of Israel, and their historic capital of Jerusalem.

We condemn the anti-Semitic voices in our own countries, which seek to falsify and distort history. Here from Budapest, the birthplace of one of the founding fathers of modern Zionism, we stand in support of the right of the Jewish people to their national homeland. We support Israel's right to defend its citizens from acts of war and terror, as is the duty of every sovereign nation. We condemn the actions of those countries in the Middle East that not only deny the rights of their citizens, but also fail to protect and systematically murder their own religious minorities. We are gravely concerned about the plight of Christians and other minorities throughout the Middle East and we encourage leaders of the free world to make a stand in their defense, lest another generation remains silent in the face of great evil. We are determined to speak out for the truth.

As Members of Parliament from European countries, we condemn the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions movement, which merely maligns and marginalizes the only democracy in the Middle East – the State of Israel. We stand in support of actions that will bring true peace – initiatives that lead to coexistence, mutual acceptance and cooperation.

We condemn in the strongest terms the recent kidnapping of three Israeli teenagers and demand the Palestinian Authority actively assist in securing their safe return.
